- Our focus is on European action in a global context and we link up with other malaria initiatives worldwide who share our vision of a malaria-free world.
- We aim through advocacy to increase funding and improve programming for malaria, demanding rigorous and resolute action against malaria as part of global efforts to reduce poverty and meet the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs).
- Targeting decision-makers and civil society at the European Union (EU) and national level, the Alliance will present a series of solution-focused recommendations based on sound practice and strong evidence.
- We also aim to work with the media in their capacity to educate, influence and ignite public dialogue, awareness and action on malaria.
- Working with partners in the South, we will focus our advocacy on the barriers that prevent effective malaria control and galvanise key stakeholders in Europe to take decisive and urgent action.
- We look to other global health advocates for areas of commonality and complementarity and seek to ensure harmonized efforts and determined action against poverty.

The European Alliance Against Malaria will focus its advocacy on:

- **Resources:** demanding the funding gap for malaria be met, and ensure improvements in the effectiveness and quality of aid.
- **Long-term Commitment:** calling for sustained political will accompanied by action; long-term and predictable financial resources; and un-relenting advocacy efforts as we build a united malaria movement for change.
- **Capacity-building:** highlighting the need for malaria-endemic countries to have increased resources for weak health systems and sufficient investment and policies to build viable health services and a retainable workforce to cope with the burden of malaria and other diseases of poverty.

- **Collaboration & coordination:** advocating for increased coordination of efforts within the malaria and donor community, as well as at country-level to harmonize efforts; calling for new and strengthened partnerships with the public sector, the South, the media and other stakeholders in global health and development.
- **Access:** ensuring that for countries hardest hit by malaria there is access to adequate financing and technical support; and for individuals and communities at risk to access effective and affordable preventative tools and medical treatment.
- **Innovation:** seeking innovative financing initiatives that will generate sufficient and sustainable resources to tackle malaria; ensure investment for innovative malaria Research and Development (R&D) and pioneer ground-breaking advocacy, information and education campaigns on malaria.
